The Reel of the Red Banner Hall

The Red Banner Hall is in Dunderave Castle located close to Inveraray, Scotland. It was the meeting place in the castle and gets its name from the tapestry wall hangings that all contain a red hue. The Clan Macnachtan Association Worldwide decided decades ago to name its membership newsletter "The Red Banner," inspired by this meeting hall. Dunderave Castle was the last castle built by the MacNaughton Clan and completed in 1596.

The music was written and played by Ewen Henderson, a multi-instrumentalist folk musician from Fort William in Scotland and was commissioned by Nick Bastin, author of three popular books, BloodBond, BloodFeud and BloodLine.
