Notes:

The two red vinyl banners may be displayed between the front and back tent poles. Attach with bungee cords. The smaller banner may be carried by two individuals in the parade of tartans.

Plastic ty-raps (two per flag pole) work best with the St. Andrews and Rampant Lion flags. Mini bungee cords (two per flag pole) work best with the American and Tartan banner flags. (this allows easy access when using the flags during the games activities. Duct tape makes a mess on the flag poles thus please avoid using. If you must use to hold up the flag poles please clean the residue prior to packing back up for shipment or storage.
